\*\*The above teachers should have postgraduate qualification with teaching experience in respective discipline. 50% of non-nursing courses/subjects should be taught by the nursing faculty. However, it will be supplemented by external faculty who are doctors or faculty in other disciplines having Post Graduate qualification in their requisite course. Nursing faculty who teach these courses shall be examiners for the concern subject. The above teachers should have postgraduate qualification with teaching experience in respective area.

**Note: -**

1. Minimum 1 M.Sc. (Nursing) faculty for each specialty i.e., Medical Surgical Nursing, Child Health Nursing, Obstetrics & Gynae. Nursing, Community Health Nursing & Mental Health is required for basic programme.
2. Part time nursing faculty will not be counted for calculating total number of faculty required for a college.
3. Irrespective of number of admissions, all faculty positions (Lecturer to Professor) must be filled.
4. For M.Sc.(N) programme appropriate number of M.Sc. faculty in each specialist be appointed subject to the condition that total number of teaching faculty ceiling is maintained.
5. All nursing teachers must possess a basic University or equivalent qualification. They shall be registered under the Maharashtra State Nursing Registration Act, 1966.
6. Nursing faculty in Nursing College except tutor / clinical instructors must possess the requisite recognized post graduate qualification in nursing subjects.
7. All teachers of nursing other than Principal and Vice-Principal should spend at least 4 hours in the clinical area for clinical teaching and / or supervision of care every day.
